

# ***What Should I Bring to Camp?***

## **Clothing:**

- 8 - 10 t-shirts/tanks for everyday wear
- 1 - 2 long sleeved t-shirts
- 1 sweatshirts/hoodies
- 1 sweater
- 1 Raincoat
- 2 – 3 comfortable bras (at least 1 sports bra)
- 6 - 10 pairs of underwear
- 3 - 4 pairs of shorts
- 1 - 2 pairs of jeans
- 2 – 3 pairs of sweatpants/track pants
- 8 – 10 pairs of socks
- 2 pairs of comfy pajamas

## **Shoes:**

- 1 pair of sturdy tennis shoes
- 1 pair of sandals

## **Bedding:**

- Sleeping bag or 1 – 2 blankets. You will be camping out.
- Fitted sheet (twin size)
- Pillow/pillowcase

## **Swimming Items:**

- Swim suit
- 2 beach towels

## **Bath/Toiletry Items:**

- 2 bath towels
- 1 washcloth/pouf
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Body wash/soap/face wash
- Deodorant
- Bug spray
- Sun Block
- Hair dryer/hair products/hair ties
- Brush/comb

- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Contact lens supplies/glasses
- Lotion
- Feminine Sanitary Products

## **Other:**

- Sunglasses
- Hat/baseball cap
- Water bottle
- Book(s)/magazine(s)
- Laundry bag

Important: bring older/less fragile items from your wardrobe – things may get ruined easily at camp. Label all items you bring to camp with your name. **DO NOT** bring expensive items such as jewelry or other keepsakes. **DO NOT** bring any pets, weapons, explosive, alcohol, or illegal drugs to camp. This list is not meant to be all-inclusive.

Please Label all belongings to be sure that they will return home with your camper.
